- 7 Canvas Boards OR Stretched Canvas Panels; 11" x 14".
- Brushes for Acrylic Paint:
  - #8 Filbert (Long handle; bristles should be about 1" long/wide), #4 Filbert (Long handle), #6 Flat, #2 Round, #1 Round, #4 Bright, #2 Bright, #0 Liner
  - 2" Diamond Trowel Palette Knife (Metal or an inexpensive plastic one is fine)
- Acrylic paints (Grumbacher Academy 90 ml Acrylic Paint will be used in class and is highly recommended; Liquitex, Winsor & Newton, etc. or other Basic or Student-Grade paint is acceptable, although please be aware that different paint brands with same-named colors often differ in appearance and pigment quality.)
  - Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue, Thalo Blue, Cerulean Blue, Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Cadmium Red Light, Grumbacher Red, Alizarin Crimson, Hooker's Green, Paynes Grey, Raw Umber, Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna, Dioxazine Purple, Yellow Ochre.
  - *Other Colors of Your Choice...*
- 9" x 12" Paper Palette. *Recommended: Strathmore 9" x 12" Paper Palette.*
- 1 Cup for Water. A regular cup will do. *Optional Recommended: Loew Cornell Round Brush Tub.*
- *Optional: Smock/Apron, Roll of paper towels, HB pencil, 12" ruler, and kneaded eraser; Table Easel.*

\*All the above art supplies can be found at Blick Art Materials, Michaels, or online. Understanding that it can sometimes be difficult to locate the correct items, especially during the current health climate due to COVID-19, and/or everything may not be found at one store, we are offering the option to purchase all the required supplies (including optional recommended supplies such as the Brush Tub and Strathmore Paper Palette) from the instructor. We'll provide a safe pick-up location for the materials you'll need for this class. Supplies can be picked up with contactless pickup, observing social distancing practices. A materials fee of \$179 is payable to the instructor at pick-up. Payment can be made in advance via Venmo @EddieBrucknerFineArt - 617-306-7502; or Zelle. Contactless Payment is preferred, but Cash/Checks will be accepted.

Painting on a table easel is often easier, less messy, and easier to see with online instruction. If you'd like to add a table easel, the cost is \$199.
